- 1. Pray for your nation.**

- 2. Pray for the Caribbean.**
A list of countries, heads of state, and populations is included on the prayer map. Pray for each by name. Pray for open hands, open doors, open minds, open hearts and open heavens for the gospel to go forth in these nations.
- 3. Pray for salvation.**
Pray for five people to be saved. List them by name on the prayer map in the space provided.
- 4. Pray for your church.**
List three things you can be praying for your church by name on the prayer map in the space provided.
- 5. Pray for yourself.**
What are three things you are believing God for this year? List them on the prayer map in the space provided.
